



Glion's new Preparatory Program

For students starting in July and October 2017, Glion Institute of Higher Education (GIHE) will offer a new Preparatory Program at its Glion campus in Switzerland. This 20-week program enables those candidates who do not meet Glion's standard admissions criteria, or those who are younger, to qualify for and enter into the Glion BBA degree program at the Swiss or London campuses.


The program learning outcome is that you will be prepared to enter into and excel in Glion's full bachelor's degree program, and you will have gained an understanding of business principles whilst having experienced studying in an international environment.

The Glion Preparatory Program (GPP)

- + A 20-week (2 X 10-week block) program that is taken before the start of the 3.5-year BBA degree program. This is available to those who are planning to study either Hospitality Management or Event, Sport and Entertainment (ESE) Management.
- + At the end of the GPP you will be required to take an access exam. If you are successful you will enter directly into Semester 1 of your bachelor degree program.
- + The program involves an intensive immersion in mathematics, finance, accounting, economics, law and general education courses.
- + Intakes for 2017: The program will take place at the Glion campus, Switzerland, in both July and October 2017.

*Students on the BBA in Hospitality Management program can select one of four specialization tracks offered in Bulle: Real Estate Finance and Revenue Management, Sales and Marketing, Luxury Brand Management, and New Venture Creation

*Students on the BBA in Event, Sport and Entertainment (ESE) Management program can select one of four specialization tracks offered in Bulle: International Entertainment Management, International Sport Management, Sales and Marketing, and New Venture Creation



Is the GPP for me?

You can now apply to enter a Glion BBA program via one of two ways:

1. If you meet the admissions criteria for the BBA you can apply for and enter directly into your 3.5-year BBA degree program in either Glion or London
2. If you do not meet the admissions criteria for the BBA you can apply for and complete the GPP before entering into your 3.5-year BBA degree program. You would start with the GPP at the Glion campus before entering Semester 1 in Switzerland (also at the Glion campus). In total, the time it would take you to complete the GPP plus your BBA degree program would be four years.

Note: All candidates' application files will automatically be evaluated on whether they meet the criteria for direct entry into the BBA.

What are the benefits of completing the GPP?

- + You will gain greater knowledge and understanding in core subjects that you will need to apply during your BBA program. You will therefore gain an advantage in skills development and will be well prepared to pass your access exam.
- + When you start your first internship you will have already had a minimum of one years' experience studying and working with others from a range of countries and backgrounds.

When Glion receives your application, the admissions team will determine if you shall be required to enter the GPP based on the above admissions criteria. The information above is supplementary to the information within Glion's undergraduate brochure.
